



Your privacy is very important to us. Our Privacy Policy describes how we collect and process your Personal Data. We encourage you to read this Policy as well as our Terms and Conditions. Please read below to see how Lavender International handles information.

1. What information do we collect about you?

We collect data about you if you purchase items on the website or register to use our services. We will also collect relevant information if you purchase or register for services by email, telephone, in person or by post.

We may also collect personal information if you complete surveys / register for a newsletter or update service / provide feedback / participate in competitions.

Website usage information is collected by using Cookies (see below).

2. Cookies

Cookies are text files placed on your computer to collect standard internet log information and visitor behaviour information. This information is used to track visitor use of the website and to compile statistical reports on website activity.

During your visit to our website you will automatically download these files to your device. The cookies we use do not identify you as an individual, only the device you are using. These cookies are a mixture of session cookies which are removed once you close your browser and persistent cookies which remain for longer, but are only active when you are on our website.

You can turn off Cookies in your internet browser (e.g. Internet Explorer, Chrome, Safari, Opera or Firefox) so they are no longer collected and the above webpage contains links to tell you how to do this. 3. How do we collect your information?

1. When you register for an account, for example to receive your examination results or purchase items from the shop
2. When you sign up to our newsletter
3. When you make a training course/examination enquiry
4. When you complete an application/registration form for your training course or examination
5. When you submit a feedback form

4. How do we use the information collected about you?

We will use the information you give us via the website in order to provide the services you have requested. Certain information is required to provide those services and these are marked by a *. Fields not marked by a * are not mandatory and we will still be able to provide the services. The non-mandatory information will be used for anonymous statistical analysis about our clients or for other purposes which you have consented to.



If you do not think we need certain information (which we have marked as mandatory) to provide our services please get in touch using the details below and we will be happy to discuss this with you.

As well as for providing the services you have requested we may use the information collected for other purposes, such as marketing. However, we will only use the information for these purposes if you have consented to us doing so.

We may provide general statistical information to reputable third parties. Such information will not allow anyone to be personally identified.

We make sure that we offer you genuine choice and control over how we use your data. If you wish to withdraw consent or change your preference about how we use your information then please contact us using the details below.

We do not transfer personal data to countries outside the EU.

The provision of your personal data is necessary to provide our services and fulfil our obligations to the relevant certification bodies. We retain data relating to BINDT training and PCN examinations for 11 years as required by the certification body.

5. Marketing

We may contact you for marketing purposes if you have consented to this when you provided your information to us. You can withdraw consent or change your preferences about marketing activities at any time by contacting us using the details below.

6. Access to your information and corrections/changes

We will only provide them with the information they require and will only permit them to use the information for the required purpose only.
